Scholar Initiative

1. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this program, applicants must hold New Zealand citizenship or permanent residency. Moreover, they should be actively engaged in esports, representing a recognized esports team at a professional level.

2. TRUTHFULNESS OF INFORMATION

Applicants must provide accurate and truthful information during the application process. Misrepresentation or falsification of facts could lead to immediate disqualification from the program.

3. SELECTION PROCEDURE

All applications will be rigorously assessed within a stipulated period of 30 days. The selection will be made according to a set of criteria defined by the NZ Esports Scholar Initiative, subject to the approval of the NZ Esports governing board. Please note that all decisions made by the board are binding and final.

4. SCHOLARSHIP USAGE

The scholarship primarily offers educational materials rather than cash awards. The responsibility of utilising these resources effectively rests with the scholars. The decision to utilise or not utilise the provided materials is entirely at the scholar's discretion.

5. RETENTION OF ELIGIBILITY

Scholars are expected to retain their professional esports status throughout their tenure in the program. Any change in their professional status should be reported immediately to the NZ Esports Scholar Initiative. However, changes to their professional status do not affect their right to continue using the scholarship materials.

6. PRIVACY

All personal data submitted during the application process will be used exclusively for the NZ Esports Scholar Initiative. The handling and storage of this information comply with the requirements of New Zealand's Privacy Act 2020.

7. NATURE OF THE INITIATIVE

The NZ Esports Scholar Initiative is not an educational institution, nor does it provide a substitute for formal education. The initiative offers materials and programs intended to augment a scholar's professional development and does not confer any formal academic accreditation.

8. CHANGES TO THE PROGRAM

The NZ Esports Scholar Initiative holds the authority to modify these terms and conditions or discontinue the program at any given time. Any such modifications or termination will be duly communicated to the applicants and scholars.
